CLINTON COUNTY SHEEP LEAD CLASS CONTEST RULES

The Clinton County Sheep Lead Class Contest will be held **Sunday, July 6, at 1:00 p.m.** on the Clinton County Fairground in the Hog Barn.

The following is a list of rules for the contest:

1. Winners are not eligible to compete in the same division the following year.
2. All lambs must be halter broken. No decoration of lambs except Pre 4-H classes.
3. The contestant's garments may be wool blend, but it is recommended to be at least 50% wool.
4. The contestant must be able to enter the ring and lead the animal without assistance.
5. All contestants will fill out a completed narration and entry form and send to: OSU Extension, 111 S. Nelson Avenue, Wilmington, OH 45177, by **June 27**. This will be used in a commentary during lead class. **Late entries will not be accepted.**
6. All entrants will be judged with respect to the garment, appearance and presentation of the sheep, and poise and performance of the entrant.
