Clinton County Junior Fair King/Queen Contest Guidelines

Eligibility

1. Contestants must be 16-19 years of age as of January 1, current year.
2. Males/Females must be members of Clinton County 4-H, FFA or other county youth organizations such as FCCLA, Scouts, school organizations, or churches.
3. Contestants may not be married, not have been married, or have borne a child.
4. Previous Clinton County Fair queens are ineligible.
5. Contestants must be willing to serve as a positive role model and abide by the Standards of Behavior printed in the 4-H and Junior Fair Requirements Book.
6. Applicant must be enrolled in a 4-H and/or FFA project during the current year.
7. Applicant must bring a scrapbook to judging that shows project involvement
8. A speech is not required, but be prepared to answer impromptu questions during the contest.
9. Applications are due in the OSU Extension Office, 111 S. Nelson Avenue, Suite 2, Wilmington OH 45177 by **May 15, 2008.**
10. Applications include: completed application form, applicant's photo and a 1-2 page typed, double spaced essay written by the applicant on a current issue affecting the junior fair.
11. Contestants will be judged on the basis of personality, poise, essay, application, responsiveness to questions during the interview and contest.

Judging:

The contest is **June 10, 6 pm,** in the Clinton County Community Room in the Clinton County Annex Building (Extension office).

Contest Dress:

- King contestants: dress slacks or khakis, dress shirt and tie.
- Queen contestants: dresses or skirt or pant suits. No strapless tops.

Judging will be based on the following: interview with judges, application form, and response to a question on stage.

All contestants must bring a scrapbook to judging that shows their project involvement

The top three finalists will be selected at the conclusion of the contest. The King/queen and his/her court will be announced at **5 p.m., July 5** on the fairground's Sound Stage.

Duties:

1. Youth selected to the Clinton County Junior Fair King/Queen court will be expected to present awards at all Junior Fair events and be present during all livestock sales according to the established schedule unless previous arrangements have been made with the JFB advisors. The Junior Fair King/Queen will crown the county fair king/queen and will participate the Ohio State Fair King/Queen Contest.

As a representative of the fair you will need to act and dress appropriately while representing the Junior Fair. If you have doubts whether or not an action or an outfit is appropriate, ask one of the advisors.

County fair dress guidelines:

Wear nice summer dresses with sleeves or wide straps, khaki-type slacks, or long dress shorts. Pierced earrings are the only pierced jewelry that may be worn. Not permitted are: tattoos, spaghetti straps, strapless or off the shoulder dresses or tops, tube tops, clothing that exposes any part of the midriff or cleavage, old or worn-looking jeans or short dresses, short skirts or short shorts.

JFB advisors will ask the King/Queen or court members to change clothes if a violation occurs. The king/queen or court members may be released from their duties and titles for violations of these guidelines.
