Major Responsibilities Include:

- Assist at Quality Assurance Trainings, weigh ins, tattooings, skillathons, check ins, and other events prior to the fair
- Assist in getting Junior Fair facilities ready for shows and events.
- Assist judges and show superintendents with show ring chores during the fair
- Attend all regular & special meetings and special events of the Junior Fair Board and show committees. If unable to attend, personally notify the Extension Office with your replacement.
- Maintain active and model membership in the 4-H program for your full term
