

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Where can I find the application(s) I need? All forms are available at the Fairfield County Extension Office or on-line at <http://fairfield.osu.edu> under the “Older Youth Opportunities” link under the 4-H Youth Development portion of the webpage.

Where can I get help with this form? Club advisors and members who have previously completed an Achievement Form are great resources. 4-H educators and staff are always willing to sit down and work with anyone interested in completing a form. (Strangely enough, they really enjoy this process and are willing to help you at any point). Call the office at 740-653-5419 to schedule an appointment.

Do I have to fill out an Achievement Form to be a Junior Leader? No, Junior Leaders can be added to the mailing list by checking the Junior Leadership box on the front page of their Achievement Form or by simply calling the office to be added to the mailing list.

How can I get on Junior Fair Board at the county level? The Selection Committee selects 4-H representatives to the Junior Fair Board by reviewing the completed applications & observing skills in the selection process of interested applicants. They select enough members for the number of positions open to 4-H in that year. Interested applicants must complete a special application and attend the selection process in January.

How do I get to be Camp Counselor? Members who have been counselors & have not been counselors both complete the response form indicating they would like an application. The Camp Counselor Application form will then be sent out to them and is due back in January. New counselors and past CITs will be asked to attend the selection process in January.

How do I get to be Camp Counselor In Training for Cloverbud Camp? THIS IS NEW FOR 2012!! Members 13 years old as of January 1st complete the response form indicating they would like an application. The Camp Counselor In Training Application form will then be sent out to them and is due back in January. CITs will be asked to attend the selection process in January.

How do I get to be a State 4-H Ambassador? Members who want to be a State Ambassador need to complete and return the Ohio 4-H Ambassador Application. This form is available upon request at the Extension Office.

How can I get a 4-H Scholarship? Completion of the Ohio 4-H Scholarship Application and resume qualifies a member for county and state 4-H scholarships. These forms are available at the Extension Office and are due in early January.

When are the Achievement Forms due? All completed forms are due into the Fairfield County Extension Office by January 13, 2012.
