



## ADVISORY COMMITTEE POLICIES FOR 2012

The 4-H Advisory Committee has agreed upon the following policies for the coming year.

1. We will collect a membership fee of \$5.00 per member paid only one time if in multiple clubs. This fee will not be required of those members participating in the county-wide fundraiser. **There will be a PENTALTY to the club of \$3.00 per member if dues are not paid by July 1.**
2. Members can pay for their Countywide dues by Selling 3 Fairfield County Fair Barn Posters. Clubs can sell the posters for more if they want to make a profit for their club. This will give the clubs and their members the opportunity to pay for their county membership dues and have a profit touse as the club and members see fit (i.e. camp scholarships, project books, etc.).
3. We are also have the Schwan Truck sale the 2nd Saturday of each month at designated sites. Locations of these trucks will be in Pickerington and East Main St Lancaster by the Chase Bank. Check the Fairfield County web site for Champaign numbers. 4-H members, family and friends can order online and also purchase cards that will benefit the 4-H Program. For each club that works 3 hours the 4-H Advisory Committee will pay \$5.00 per member up to \$50.00 per club.

Enrollments folders will be verified by the Advisory Committee. At that time a statement will be sent to the clubs for payment of fees. Checks only for the Enrollment fees per statement will be sent to the 4-H Advisory Treasurer who's address will be on the statement.

Clubs may want to consider paying this membership fee with their treasury money rather than asking each member. If you have members who are unable to pay for any reason, paying with treasury money or having the member participate in the countywide fundraiser will cover this cost.

Clubs that do not pay their dues by the March Update will be considered disbanded.
