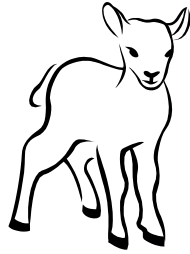

7. Ride in the 4th of July parade at Wilmington, Clarksville or Blanchester.
