2. 4-H Members who lease animals must have them in their possession and continual care by **May 1**. The leased animal must be kept at 4-H member's home. Exception: The care of a 4-H'er who lives in town or rural non-farm with no buildings to house animal.
3. It is understood by both lessee and lessor that while animal is in lessee's care, it should be treated as if his/her own animal. All awards won by 4-H'er and the animal belong to the lessee. The lessee is responsible for the animals agreed upon in section 1.
4. If animal is being mistreated, the owner has the right to break the lease agreement and redeem animal, provided there is proof of mistreatment.
5. After the Clinton County Fair, the animal is to be returned to lessor and the responsibilities of 4-H member relinquished unless other arrangements are made.

This lease agreement must be signed by all parties with picture of animal attached and filed in the Extension Office by **June 1**, (\*Dairy Exhibitors due **May 1**)
