

## How much will it cost?

The 4-H Cloverbud Day Camp fee is \$25 and includes:

- lunch
- snacks
- t-shirt
- craft supplies
- activity supplies



Camp is open to 4-H Cloverbud members and non-members age 5 and in Kindergarten until the member reaches age 8 and third grade. Registration turned in by June 1 includes a camper t-shirt. Late camp registrations will be accepted until June 11 for \$30. Late registrations will not receive a camp t-shirt. Make checks payable to "OSU Extension Office."

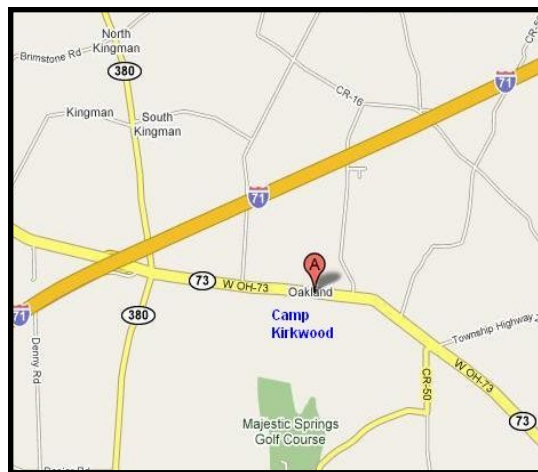
## Where is Camp?

### What is expected from the Cloverbud Campers?

Our goal is for campers to have fun and be safe at camp while respecting the adult staff and teen counselors. Campers will have the opportunity to work independently, in small groups, and participate in team activities. Please go over basic rules with your child before sending them to Cloverbud Day Camp.



### What do I take to Camp?

Old play clothes, sunscreen, tennis shoes, water bottle with identification, bag, medication with doctor's signature if needed, insect repellent, a jacket, rain coat or sweat-shirt and fun theme clothing or items. And make sure campers wear a bathing suit to play water games and bring a beach towel.

### When is Camp?

Cloverbud 4-H Day Camp is June 15. Campers may begin arriving at 8:45 a.m. and will be released at 4:30 p.m.

### What's at Camp?

Campers will have the opportunity to explore the rustic cabins located on over 200 acres. The camp facilities include several nature trails, craft and activity pavilion, 3 campfire sites, basketball courts, tetherball, a sand volleyball court, archery range, fossiling areas, swimming pool, a lake for fishing and canoeing, and a lodge with a conference center.
