DIRECTIONS TO COLLEGE

From the South - Take I-71 N to State Rt. 73. Turn right onto SR 73 and follow 73 East through Wilmington to College Street. Turn Right on College Street.

From the North - Take I-71 S. to State Rt. 68. Turn left and follow 68 South into Wilmington. Turn left onto Main Street and follow through Wilmington to College St. Turn Right on College.

From the East - Take State Rt 22-3 west through Wilmington. Turn left onto College St.

From the West - Take State Rt 73 through Wilmington. Turn right onto College Street
