Cooking Challenge for ALL Junior Fair Members

Members don't need to have a foods & nutrition project. Members show up with the supplies and prepare the recipe!
Saturday, July 10, Peterson Building
6:30 p.m. Beginner, 7:00 p.m. Intermediate, 7:30 p.m. Advanced
Entry Deadline: Noon the day of event.
Awards will be presented after each division.
The Cooking Challenge is open to any 4-H member.
The purpose of the cooking challenge is to demonstrate food preparation skills by preparing a recipe using safe work habits. Participants will also gain knowledge in product evaluation.

Contestants will have 30 minutes to set up, prepare product and clean up. There is to be no talking or other communication between audience and 4-H'ers. Working table space will be provided. Participants are to bring their own ingredients, utensils, and necessary appliances. All participants are to use the recipes found in this section. Judging results are based on food preparation, clean up and the finished product. All preparation, including measuring, needs to be done before the judge unless otherwise stated in the recipe.

Sewing Challenge for ALL Junior Fair Members

Members don't need to have a clothing project. Members show up and supplies are provided!
Saturday, July 10, Peterson Building
6:30 p.m., Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced, Peterson Building
Entry Deadline: Noon the day of event.
Awards presented immediately following each division. At the sewing challenge, each age group will have a different task to complete. The work will be done on pre-cut sample-size items of 100% cotton or cotton blend for beginners and intermediates. Advanced fabric may differ to demonstrate the skill. All contest supplies will be provided. Participants will be given 30 minutes to complete the skill. Participants will be judged on neatness, technique, time management, and the finished item. **YOU MAY BRING AND USE YOUR OWN MACHINE, IF DESIRED.**

Pollorum Testing (Poultry Department)

Pollorum testing will be on the following dates:

July 7, 6-8pm (Fairground/Shelter at Jr. Fair Building)

July 14, 3:30-6:30pm during fair project move in. (Fairground-Poultry Barn)

The Ohio Department of Agriculture and the Ohio Poultry Association require a negative Pullorum Typhoid test. Pullorum testing is required on all birds over 4 months of age. Pullorum and AI testing are required to be tested every 12 months. You must provide a copy of this testing on the day of check in. If you cannot provide hatch papers showing the testing results that are dated less than 12 months you must have your birds tested for Pullorum. If hatch papers or proof of Pullorum/NPIP free testing within the past 365 days are not available, the exhibitor must have the bird or birds tested during the county Skillathon.

Fair Wristbands

All Junior Fair Members & Advisors that meet the club-meeting requirement will receive a fair wristband for daily admission to the fair. Members and volunteers must pick it up during the designated pickup times:
