## **Dairy Rules**

- 1. **May 1** entries include:
  - a. <u>For registered animal, 1. entry form and (Bring photocopy or original registration paper to fair for</u> animal check in.)
    - \*If registration is pending at time of entry a picture of the animal with tattoo/tag is required.
- 2. May 1 lease forms include: 1. lease agreement and 2. photo of project animal
- 3. All Jr. Fair animals must be registered in the member's name and/or signed lease and members must bring papers to the fair. All entries will be checked.
- 4. All animals must have been completely and fully owned or leased including all showing rights by the exhibitor. All exhibitors must provide for complete and continual care of their animal(s) on and after **May 1**, current year.
- 5. An exhibitor may show a maximum of two animals per class with no limit on total number of animals that can be shown.
- 6. Members are required to wear white for show; no advertising in showmanship.
- 7. Registration for showmanship will be taken during the barn meeting.
- 8. Showmanship participants must show his/her own Jr. Fair project animals. The showmanship divisions are as follows:
  - a. Senior Showmanship 14-18 years old
  - b. Intermediate Showmanship 12-13 years old
  - c. Junior Showmanship 10-11 years old
  - d. Beginner Showmanship 8-9 years old
- 9. No Grade animals
- 10. Each Jr. Fair exhibitor is responsible for his/her animals. Stalls must be properly bedded and aisles clear at all times.
- 11. Dairy members may participate in the dairy sale and are eligible to sell 1 project in the junior fair sale. Exhibitors wanting to participate in the junior fair auction must participate in showmanship, dairy show and turn in a sale card. Sale cards must be turned into the announcers stand during the dairy show or turned into the Senior Fair Office by 6:30 p.m. on Thursday of the fair.
- 12. The Lawrence Dean Memorial Outstanding Dairy Exhibitor Award divisions are as follows:
  - a. a. Senior Division 14-18 years old
  - b. b. Junior Division 8-13 years old

The Lawrence Dean Memorial Outstanding Dairy Exhibitor Award will be determined using four 25-point categories:

•Top placing animal – one animal only, any breed. 1st, 25 pts. 2nd, 20 pts., 3rd, 15 pts., 4th, 10 pts.,5th, 5 pts.

•Showmanship, one class only. 1st, 25 pts. 2nd, 20 pts., 3rd, 15 pts., 4th, 10 pts., 5th, 5 pts.

Skillathon, a 25 point test will be set up by the Dairy Committee. Only test scores from the designated dates will be used. Those not taking the Skillathon during the county dates are ineligible for this award. See Livestock Rules for additional Skillathon regulations.
Herdsmanship, 3 days using 4-6 different judges. Judging at unannounced times during each day.

1st, 25 pts. 2nd, 20 pts., 3rd, 15 pts., 4th, 10 pts.,5th, 5 pts.

•Any overall tiebreaker will be determined by Herdsmanship placing.

•An individual cannot win in their division two consecutive years.

- 13. The Dairy Committee is responsible for interpretation of these rules.
- 14. Additional rules are under Junior Fair Rules and Livestock Rules.

  - Winter Yearling, born Dec. 1, 2021 thru Feb. 28, 2023
- Fall Yearling Heifer, born Sept. 1, 2021 thru Nov. 30, 2022
- Junior Two Year Old Cow, born March 1 thru Aug. 31, 2022
- Senior Two Year Old Cow, born Sept. 1, 2021 thru Feb. 28, 2022
- Junior Three Year Old Cow, born March 1 thru Aug. 31, 2021
- Senior Three Year Old Cow, born Sept. 1, 2020 thru Feb. 28, 2021
- Four Year Old Cow born Sept. 1, 2019 thru Aug. 31, 2020
- Aged cow, Five Year Old and over, born before Sept. 1, 2019
