

## 2023 4-H Chartering Checklist for Your 4-H Club

Please complete this checklist to determine whether your club has met the Ohio 4-H Club charter requirements. This checklist will be reviewed by your County 4-H Extension Professional. Chartered 4-H clubs are permitted to use the 4-H Name and Emblem according to 4-H National Headquarters guidelines. Clubs that meet these minimum requirements will be granted/continue a charter. The charter checklist must be reviewed every year to assure a club's continued compliance with the 4-H Club criteria.

Clubs that meet these minimum requirements will be granted a charter for a period of one year. Charters must be renewed every year from the date of issue.
