The **Ed Reed Memorial Contesting Rotating Trophy** will be awarded to the 4-H member with the fastest combined time in all 4 speed events. If no exhibitors have 4 qualifying times, then the trophy will be awarded to the exhibitor with the 3 fastest times. The member will designate by June 1 entry deadline the horse they will be using. Entries are limited to one per member/one horse. Those designated high point classes, one rider/horse may not be cross entered in any other rotating high point competitions.

Walk Trot Beginners are not eligible to participate in the High Point completion.

To Qualify for any Horse High Point award, you must complete the Horse Skillathon.
